- Generally navigating around the world of work

Skills needed from a volunteer mentor include:

- Capacity for non-judgmental listening
- Enthusiasm for meeting people from diverse backgrounds
- Willingness to share wisdom gained from life experiences
- Desire to work alongside the client to further his or her growth
