The words of Dr. King urge us, as a community, to recognize our role as just that: a community.

Interfaith Works is proud to announce that Supriya Mordecai, M.S., is Interfaith Works' new Director of Essential Needs, which includes the Interfaith Works Clothing Center, Food Pantry and Connections Programs. The Essential Needs Center provides individuals and families with limited income access to clothing, home goods, food, other community resources and emergency rental and utility assistance at no charge to them.

Supriya joined Interfaith Works in 2021 and spent nearly two years as a Case Manager serving clients at the Interfaith Works Drop-In Center and Shelter at Progress Place in Silver Spring (formerly known as the Empowerment Center). Supriya assisted with Case Management at other IW locations before becoming the Program Director at Progress Place in January 2023.

All week long, volunteers came to our sites to provide meals to clients, helped at the Essential Needs Center, and collected donations to support our clients.

2023, A Year In Review

THANKS TO GENEROUS DONORS LIKE YOU, IN THE PAST YEAR WE:

- Served more than **19,700 families** experiencing food insecurity with 676,000+ pounds of free food and 164,000+ diapers.
- Supported **7,800+ people** with free clothing and home goods.
- Prevented **358 households** from experiencing eviction and possible homelessness, and supported **229 households** with utility assistance.
- Helped **71 clients** find jobs at an average hourly wage of \$16.67, resulting in more than \$2.4 million in total annual salary.
- Provided emergency shelter and supportive housing to 1,200 neighbors.
