Help Provide the Items Needed to Move Into a New Home

Interfaith Works is partnering with Montgomery County in a campaign to end chronic homelessness by March 2018, known as "Inside (Not Outside)." As we work towards this goal, men and women who previously experienced homelessness are finding stability by moving into IW's permanent supportive housing programs.

Help welcome them to their new homes by donating a laundry basket filled with essential items:

Bedding

- Queen-size sheet sets with blanket/quilt or
- Pillows

Bath

- Towels and wash cloths
- Toilet mats
- Small rugs

Toiletries

- Toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo/conditioner, body wash, hand soap, hair brush, lotion, sanitizer.

House goods

- Trash bins & Trash bags (medium and small)
- Laundry baskets & detergent
- Storage bins/ room organizers
- Paper towels and toilet paper
- Dish washer soap
- Cleaning supplies: Lysol wipes, toilet bowl cleaner, All-purpose cleaner, toilet brush, Swiffer with wipes, broom and dust pan.

Dining

- Plates, cups, and cutlery
- Food (dry goods, canned goods, or microwaveable foods)
