Orthodontics, braces, and oral surgery are also offered. The hospital accepts most insurance plans and Medicaid. Eligible patients may receive discounted services through the hospital's Financial Assistance Policy.

Dental treatment in the predoctoral clinic is provided by dental and dental hygiene students under the supervision of faculty members. Prospective students are primarily selected on the basis of their teaching potential and therefore may not be accepted into the predoctoral program. When this occurs, patients are referred to one of the college's postdoctoral programs for evaluation. Patients who are not accepted into a postdoctoral program will receive a list of private practitioners for possible care. Postgraduate dentists also provide general dental treatment and specialized care in oral and maxillofacial surgery, pediatric dentistry and orthodontics.
