Interfaith Works Programs 301.762.8682

Becky's House, Rockville, provides permanent supportive housing in an eight-bed home for older women who previously have experienced homelessness.

Emergency Assistance Coalition, a program managed by Interfaith Works, is a network of providers who deliver emergency assistance to needy residents of Montgomery County and includes public agencies, congregations, grassroots local assistance groups and other human service providers groups.

Friends in Action serves 42 families with case management and with help of 200+ trained volunteer mentors.

Interfaith Homes houses 31 chronically homeless, disabled men and women annually in scattered-site, permanent supportive housing.

Interfaith Housing Coalition provides permanent housing with supports for 25 families in multiple locations.

Interfaith Network of Montgomery County is a unique public-private partnership between IW and the Montgomery County Faith Community Advisory Council to assist faith communities in meeting residents' needs.

Interfaith Works Clothing Center, Rockville, provides free clothing and household goods to 12,900 income-qualified residents each year, including nearly 6,000 children.

Interfaith Works Connections, Rockville, links low-income residents to essential resources including food, emergency assistance, eviction prevention and vocational services.

Interfaith Works Empowerment Center at Progress Place, Silver Spring, provides day programs, case management, vocational services, showers, laundry and emergency shelter in weather extremes.

Interfaith Works Residences, Silver Spring, provides permanent supportive housing units to 21 vulnerable men and women who previously experienced homelessness, along with services to support their successful transition to housing.

Interfaith Works Women's Center, Rockville, provides emergency shelter, meals, vocational services and case management to more than 250 women annually.

Vocational Services Program engages 250 low-income and homeless individuals in job-readiness classes, intensive career counseling and training, and provides one-on-one job placement services in Rockville, Silver Spring and Gaithersburg.

Watkins Mill House, Gaithersburg, provides transitional shelter in an eight-bed home for women with behavioral health challenges who previously experienced homelessness
